

## Pastor's Notes



**Happy New Year!** It is hard for me to believe I have completed more than ½ year (7 months) in our community. I think that is so because I am learning so much about how our parish operates, and who does what. I want you to know that I am very happy here. You have been very welcoming to me, plus very engaged in our parish. I am especially grateful to all who have met with me in our *Listening Sessions* so that I could learn how you feel about our parish. These experiences make me feel confident about our future together as Saint Clare Parish & School. It gives me pause to thank God for bringing us together and to thank you for being so welcoming and engaged. On behalf of our staff, I wish you a **Happy & Blessed New Year!**

School News – I have several items to share with you.

- 1) Our **Challenge Appeal** has reached \$71,000, that's \$11,000 more than I asked for. God works in mysterious ways as we have discovered a shortfall in the budget centering around our Benefits package. To date, we have paid all our bills for the school but still need an additional inflow of cash (to be determined) to cover what seems to be a budgeting error.
- 2) We are beginning a new marketing campaign to fill the 230 seats of our school. I am calling it **Project 230**. We know that if we fill each seat of the present classrooms, we can distribute the costs over more students. The more students we have the quicker we arrive at a balanced budget. We are hoping to not raise the tuition rate for next year. Now we need each of you to act as ambassadors. You have tremendous power to reach out to your family friends, neighbors and coworkers and invite them to check out our school.
- 3) Our new marketing campaign involves a new logo. Here is the slogan: ***I believe in Catholic Schools, I believe in Saint Clare.*** You will see this on Tee Shirts, bumper stickers, etc. I am going to ask each of you who share our appreciation for our school, to wear a shirt and put a bumper sticker on your car.
- 4) **Top 40 Reunion Celebration** – will be on January 16<sup>th</sup>. All Alumni of our school from 1962 to 2002 are invited. We will begin with the 4 pm Mass, followed by a Top 40 reception. It's FREE. Food, Fun, Games and Open Bar will be provided (hence the cutoff of 2002). We are trying to assemble the largest gathering of Alumni in Saint Clare History! Show your support for Catholic Schools and Show YOUR support for Saint Clare School!

Our next listening session will be held on Tuesday, January 26<sup>th</sup> and will focus on ways to pay off our **Parish Debt**. This topic came from our floor at our second listening session. By that time I hope to have a 6 month report so you can see how we are doing this year. As have done with the last 3 sessions, we will open the doors at 6:30 pm and begin our listening session at 7:00 pm. The night will be complete by 8:30 pm. No matter what age you are, all are welcomed to come and lend their voices as we build our futures together. Next up will be a convocation (Listening Session) of Youth of our parish. I am anxious to hear their voices.

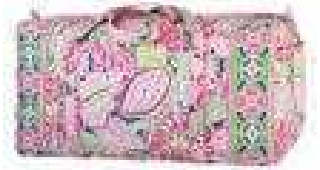
